




GEARY AT PARK PRESIDIO IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT SURVEY RESULTS

The Geary at Park Presidio Improvements Project aims to provide a safer and more inviting environment for Muni passengers, pedestrians, runners, and vehicular traffic at the intersection of Geary Boulevard at Park Presidio Boulevard. Our goal is to create a design that reflects the needs of the community and reinforces neighborhood identity. Concepts to be considered for the Geary at Park Presidio Improvements Project include: seating, decorative sidewalks, plazas, and gateway planting.

The public was able to provide input through our online survey until May, 2017. The survey had 237 respondents.




What do you like about the existing intersection at Geary and Park Presidio? (165 respondents)




Other: awning, safe, visible stoplights, clean, trash cans, gas station, no construction, beautiful
