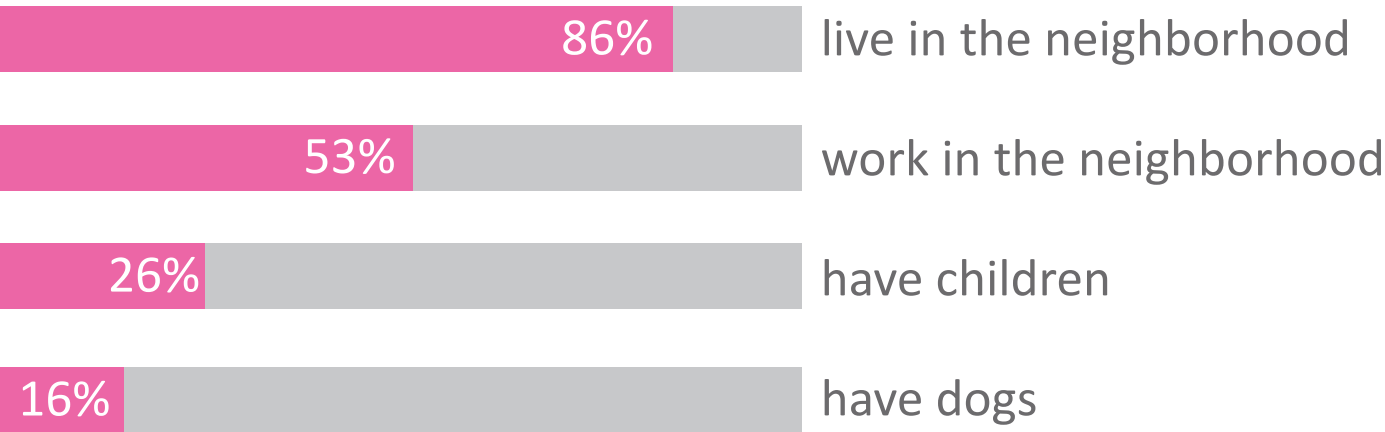

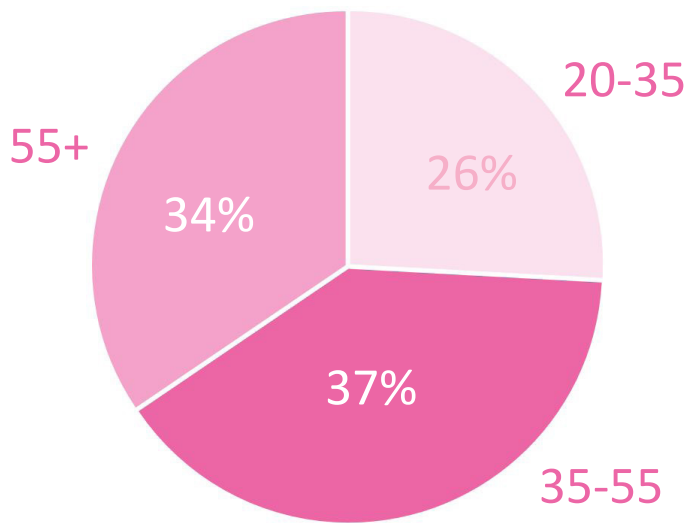

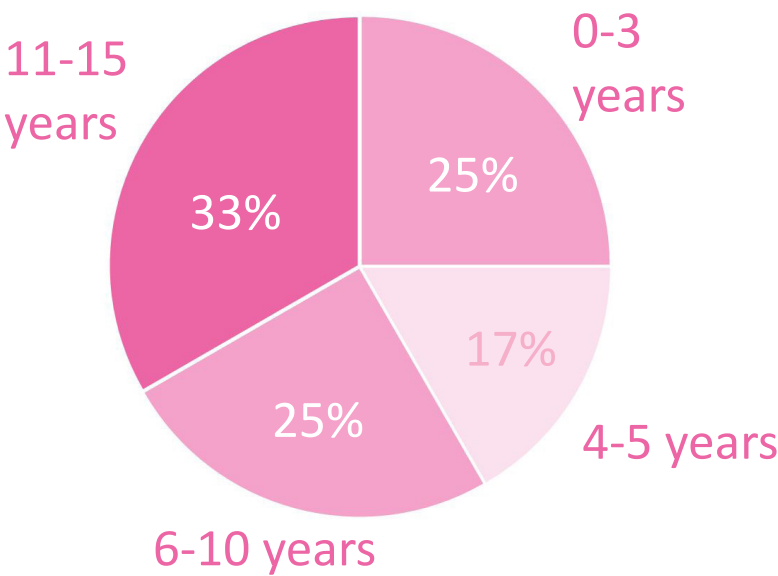


Age of Respondents:

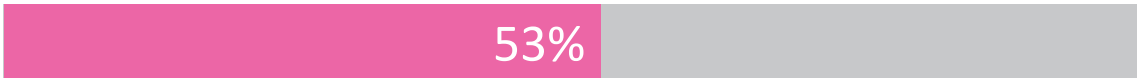

Option 1: Envelop



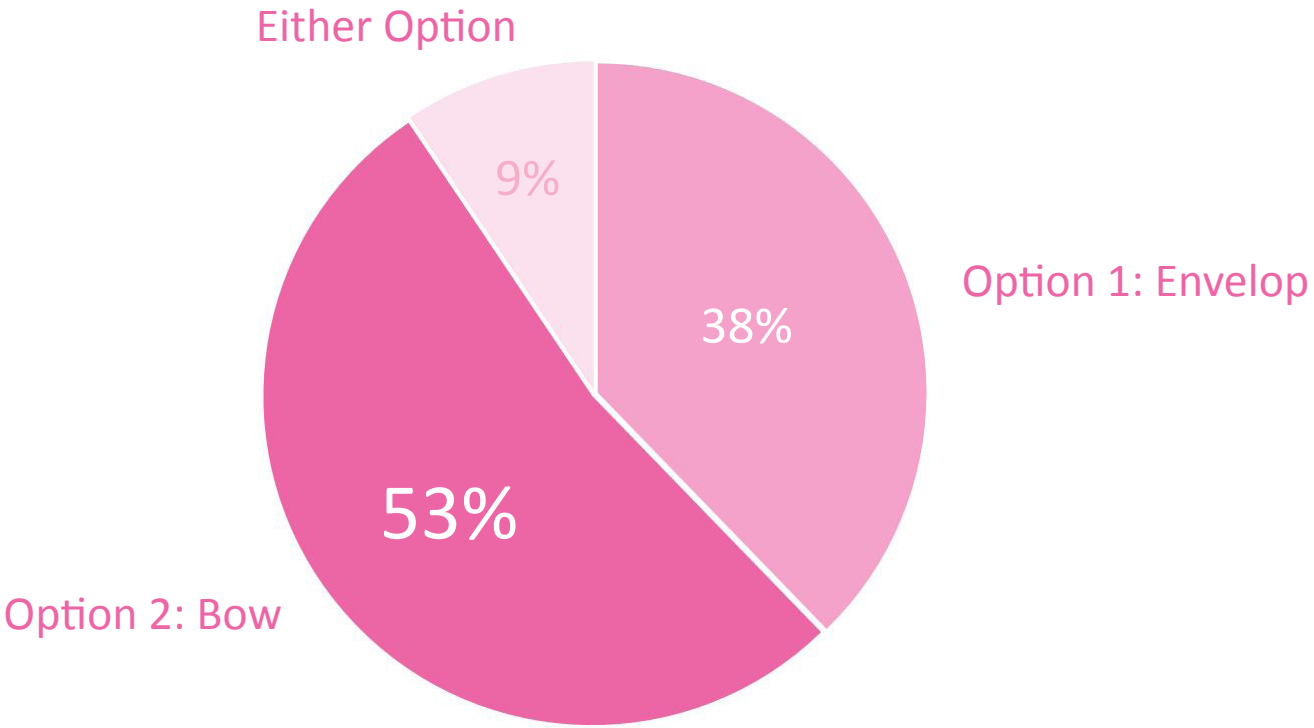
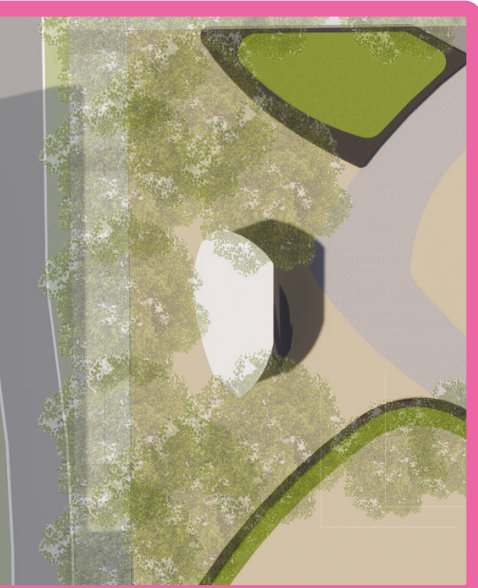
- Prismatic form
- Offset location within grove
- Responds to new architectural forms nearby
- Perforated metal skin
- Can glow internally at night



Option 2: Bow



- Organic form frames views to each corner
- Central location within grove
- Replicates curves from site design
- Earthy materials and color palette
- Integrated with landscape

“More harmonious with the site. “Bow” looks like it belongs there!”

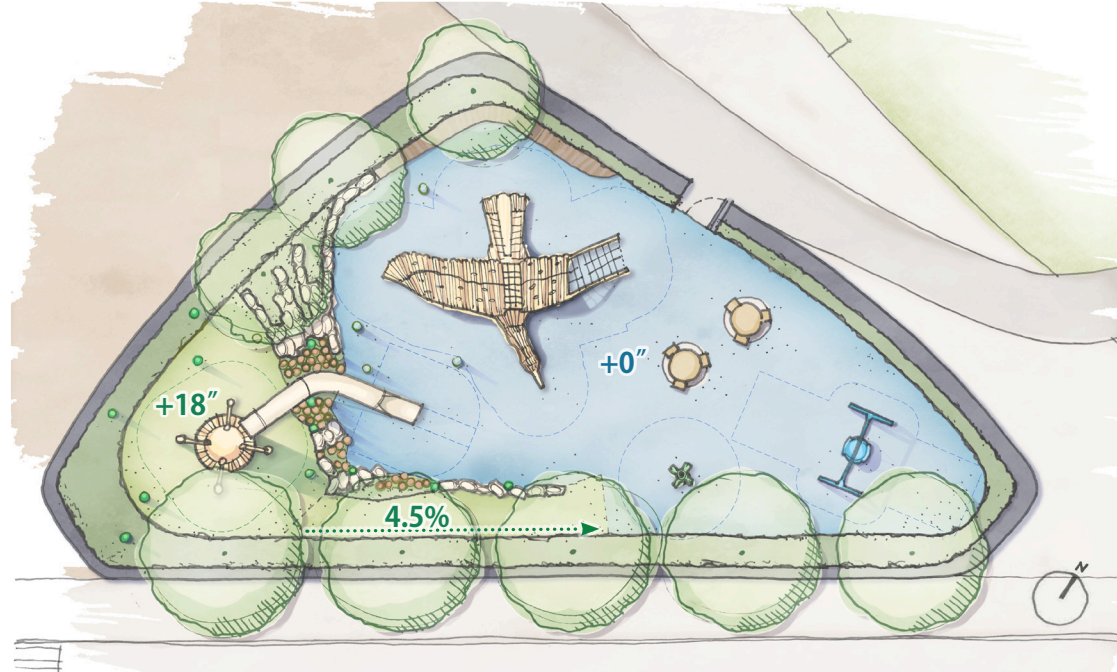
“Very strong preference for the more organic form of Option 2.”

“I like the curves for the Bow option but the glowing internally at night tipped the scale to the Envelop option.”

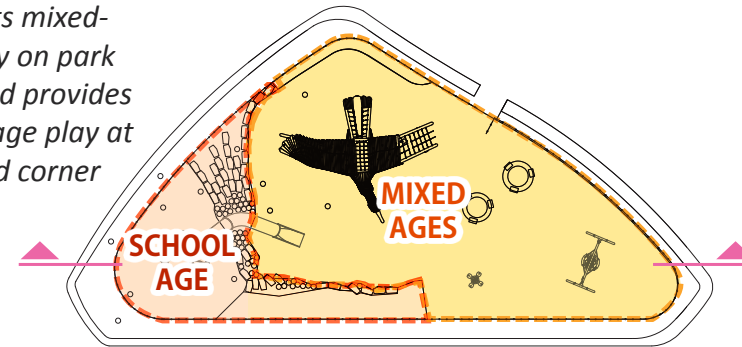

Option 1: Integrated Play



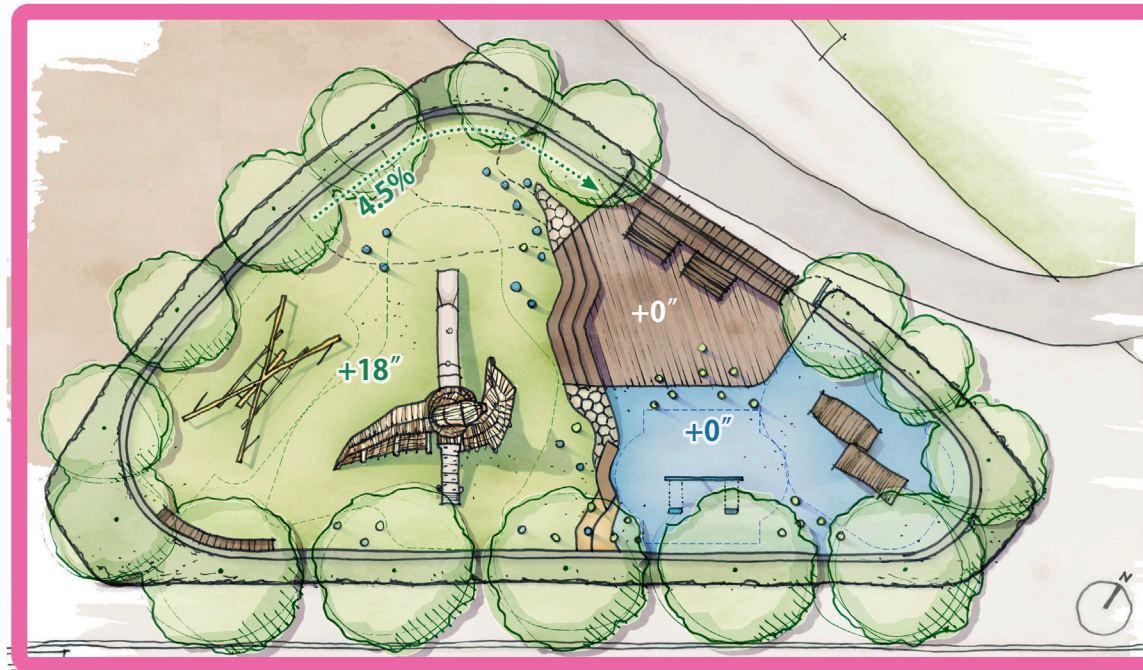
Supports mixed-age play on park level and provides school age play at elevated corner



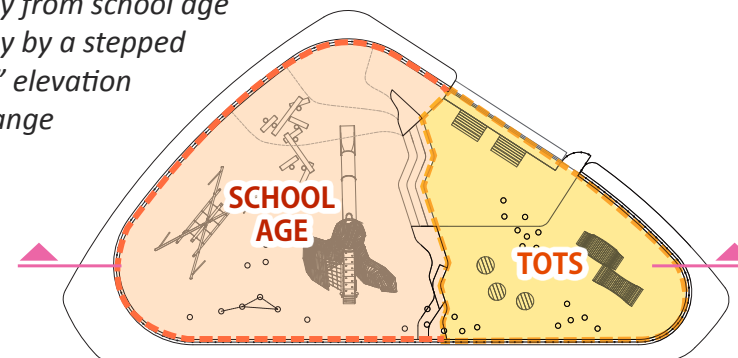
Elevated (18")

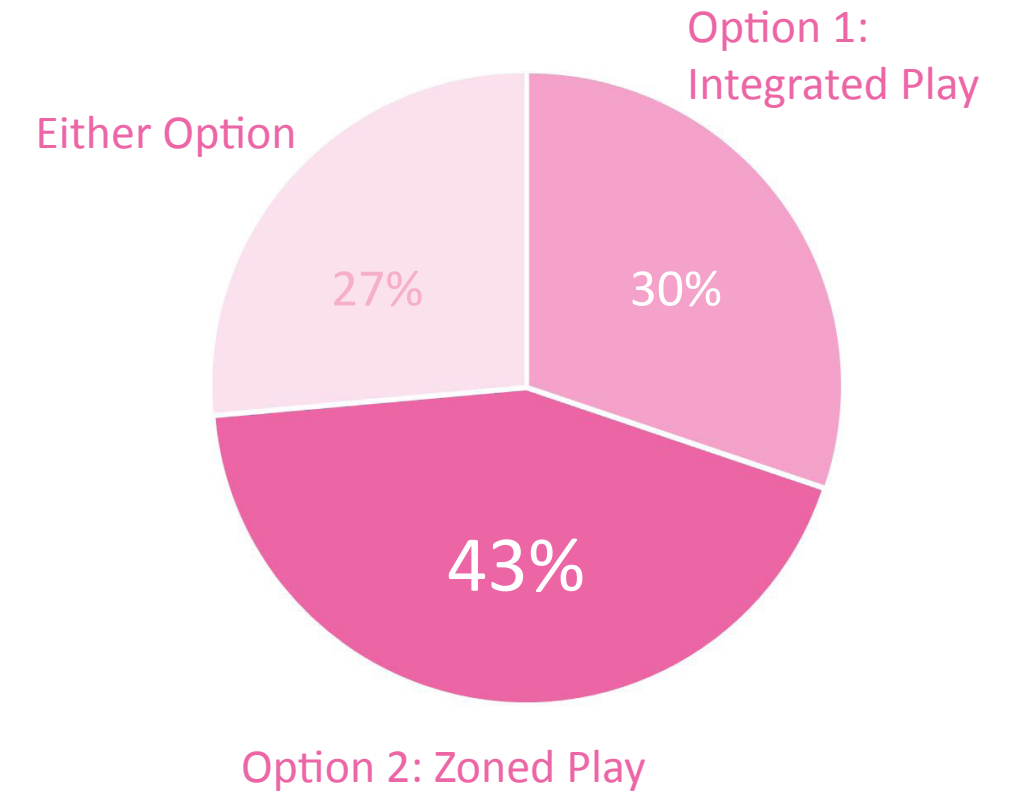
Option 2: Zoned Play

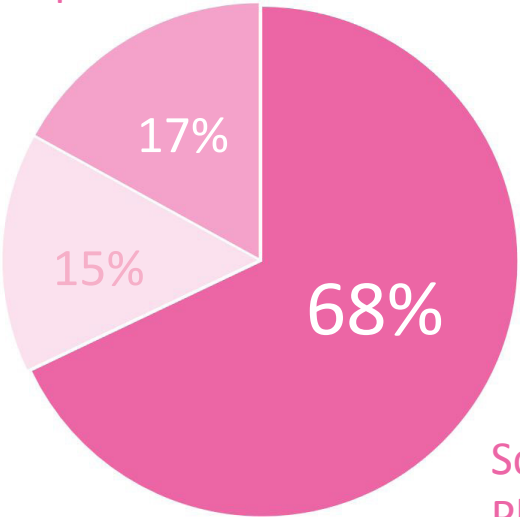

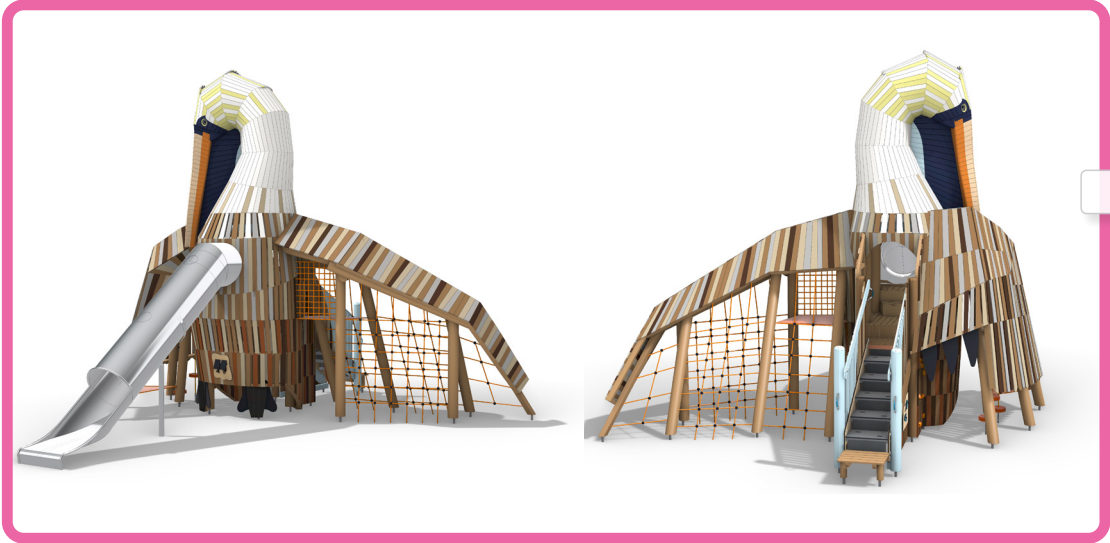

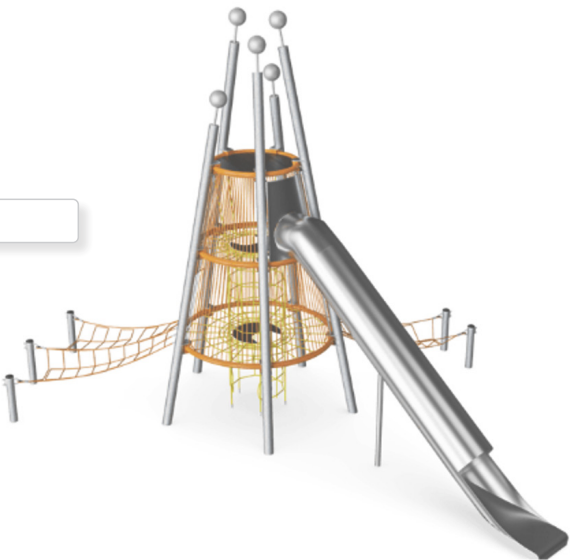

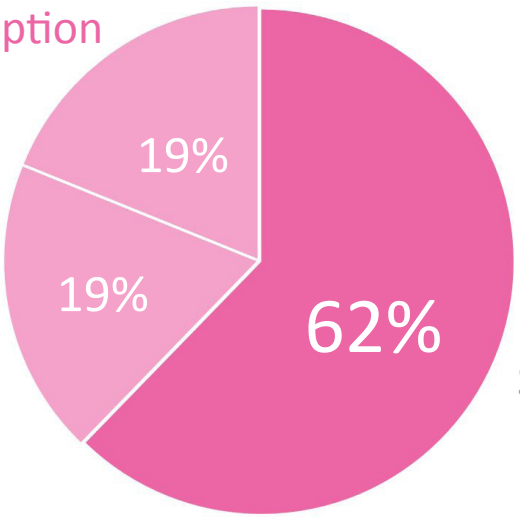

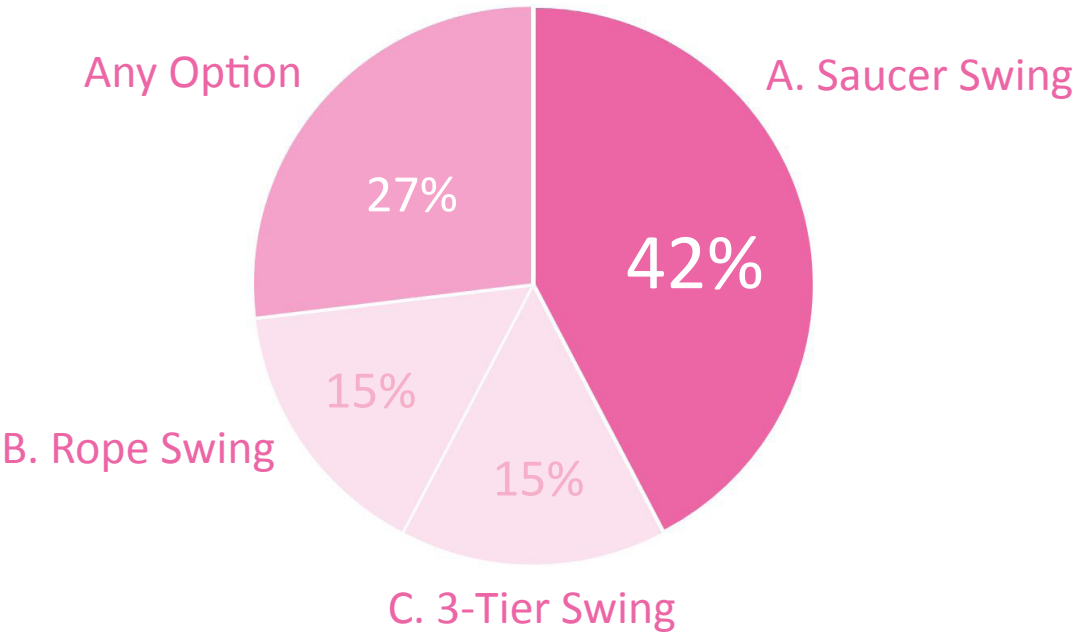

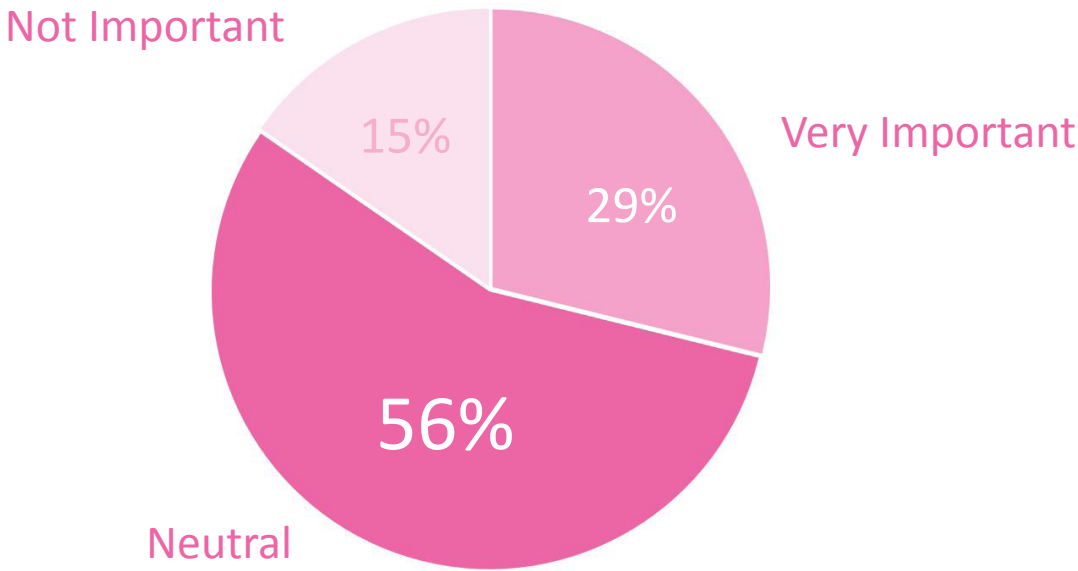
